WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the first edition of BAUHAUS Royal Rally of Scandinavia

The rally will take place 6-8 July in the region of Värmland and in the city of Karlstad.

Locations

The Rally Village will be at Färjestad (near the throttle track) known from SSS Karlstad i Rally Sweden for many years. Here you will find the Headquarter, Media centre, Service park and start/finish podium.

Route

The total length of the route is 861,17 km and the special stage length is 182,60 km. A complete itinerary is enclosed in Appendix 1.

The competing part starts with the Bäck-Hult qualifying stage on Thursday at 14:05.

Friday morning the rally will go east of Karlstad and Saturday morning the rally is going west and north of Karlstad. Both days with a loop of four stages before coming back to Karlstad for a midday service, before they copy the loop in the afternoon.

On Saturday the classic stage Vargåsen (now called Colin's) with the famous Colin's Crest will go as Live TV stages in the middle of the day and as Power stage in the afternoon.

3.2. CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

The number of entrants is limited to 80 cars. If more than 80 entries are received, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

Those wishing to take part in the BAUHAUS Royal Rally of Scandinavia must register and fill in the electronic entry form duly completed before the closing date for entries (Wednesday 21 June 2023 at 23:59 (CET)).

Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. The FIA will need time to register you in the system and open your user account. Please do not wait until the last moment to make your entry in order not to miss the entry closing date. The user account application is available through a link on the registration page stated above.

The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the Entry fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of payment of the entry fee by e-mail to the secretary of the rally

competitor@ercroyalrally.com by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN in the same email.

After online registration, competitors must send simultaneously by e-mail to competitor@ercroyalrally.com the following documents in PDF format:

Competitors must present in the administrative checks, the originals of the documents requested above. In case of missing documents requested above, the Organiser may reject the application.

Confirmation of registration will be sent by mail and with the publication of the Entry List.

4. SERVICE PARK

4.1. LOCATION

GPS Coordinates: N59°24'439,E13°30'314

The service park will be established at Löfbergs Arena/Färjestads Travets Södra parkering, Norra Infarten 79, 651 08 Karlstad Karlstad (see city map in Appendix D)

4.2. RESTRICTIONS ON THE SERVICE PARK

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the tarmac or the ground at the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and others that need to be fastened.

Mandatory for all competitors to use ground sheets for ground protection under competing car during the service. This ground sheet must be sufficiently strong, i.e., impermeable to oil, fuel, cooling, brake fluid and battery acid. Teams and competitors are responsible for the occurrence of no leakage of fuel or other liquids on the ground.

Smoking is forbidden in the refuelling-zones.

Service Vehicles

In the Service Park. Service cars are only allowed to set-up at times according to Art. 4.3

For all teams to access the designated service space during the rally the vehicles must carry a Service plate and use the auxiliary entrance. The Vehicle must be parked inside the designated area. It's not allowed to park vehicles, recce car on the road section at the servicepark.

Roads and space are limited at the service park. Please respect service times to avoid congestion.

The number of service plates allowed is included in the entry fee (see 3.5. Entry Packages)

Auxiliary Vehicles

There is two auxiliary parkings, one at the servicepark and the second beyond Headquarter

For access to the Auxiliary parking area the vehicles must carry an Auxiliary plate or Service plate.

Vehicles with VIP plates have access only to the second auxiliary parking beyond HQ.

Trolley Parking

There is parking for transport-trolleys or small vans beyond headquarters (see appendix C)

Medical Unit

A medical unit will be established at the spectators entrance, see service park drawing in appendix C

Water Supply

Fresh water will be available from a big water tank, see servicepark drawing.

There is no running water at the servicepark, so teams and competitors are asked to bring drums to collect freshwater from the big water tank.

4.6. RECYCLING / ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

For environmental reasons we kindly ask teams and competitors to use the recycling areas arranged at the service park (marked on the Service Park drawings). Garbage containers will also be available for combustible waste. Oil, drums, spare parts etc may not be left on the service park under any circumstances. A special container for Hazardous Waste will be put in the Service area marked Eco-Simplex, in which the teams can place oil, fluids, lamps, electronic waste, absorbents etc. Empty drums and spare parts can also be put in or close to this container.

Any team/competitor who does not use recycling areas-garbage containers and leave waste at the service bay will be charged a penalty fee of 10 000 SEK

4.7. CAR WASH

For environmental reasons, it is strictly forbidden to wash cars or trucks at the service park.

There is no possibility to wash the rally car along the Rally route.

5. FUEL / TYRES

5.1. FUEL

Fuel must be in compliance with Appendix J art. 252.9 (RRSR art 62)

For environmental and safety reasons, all competitors must refuel in the designated refuel areas. Except as detailed in the regulations for the change of fuel tank, RRSR art 58.

5.1.1. Fuel restrictions for Junior ERC

Competitors in the Junior ERC Championship are allowed to use only pump filling station fuel (gasoline type 98) from the following petrol station:

Service crews are allowed to fill this fuel in their cans or drums and refuel Junior ERC cars in designated Refuelling Areas.

5.2. REFUELLING

5.2.1. Refuelling Areas

Except as detailed in Art. 58 of FIA RRSR, competitors may refuel only in the designated Refuelling Areas..

5.2.2. Refuelling procedure

Solely for the purpose of assisting with the refuelling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew with the team passes may access the Refuelling Area. In order to access the Refuel area, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling. At the Refuel area, the competitor is responsible to protect the ground with an Environmental Mat which shall be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part.

5.3. COMMERCIAL FILLING STATIONS

There will not be any options to use commercial filling stations during this rally.

5.4. REFUELLING DURING THE RALLY

Refuel area will be as follows:

Thursday 6 July Service park 09:00 – 15:00

Friday 7 July Service park (after TC 0 and 4C)
Remote refuel Ölmhult after SS 2 and 6

Saturday 8 July Service park (after TC 9E and 12C)
Remote refuel Södra Ås after SS 11 and 15

5.5 TYRES

All tires must comply with Art. 13 of the RRSR in conjunction with Appendix V of the RRSR.

5.5.2 Tyres for Junior ERC Championship

For the Junior ERC Championship, only Hankook tyres, sold at the rallies by the Junior ERC Championship tyre supplier, are eligible.

A driver may use only those tyres that have been registered for his car. Any tyre registered for a driver at a previous rally must be presented at the tyre supplier for checking and new registration before it can be used on a rally by the same driver.










